## **APG Current State**

#### **STATS**

- 94% workforce civilian/contractor
- ❖ 6<sup>th</sup> largest employer in MD with more than 21k employees
- Supports around 40k jobs
- Pay more than \$2.1 billion in wages annually
- ❖ APG Contracting \$13 billion in FY20









#### APG remains committed to research and modernization efforts

## **COVID-19 Update**


**Our COVID safety measures:**


## **Engagement Opportunities**
